

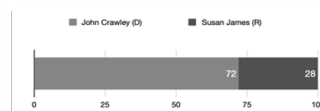

**Election Vignette:**

In a local city council race, Democratic candidate John Crawley is running against Republican candidate Susan James. Dem candidate Crawley is running on a platform which includes increasing access to public transportation, addressing homelessness, and affordable living. GOP candidate James focuses on increasing police funding and freezing taxes on local businesses. In the most recent televised town hall, moderators pointed to the stark contrast between the candidates' views on most key issues. The candidates go head-to-head on the issue of safe injection sites, which Crawley favours but James opposes.

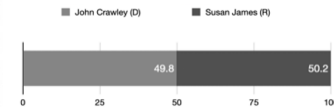
**Treatment Group 1: Lopsided**

Reputable polls predict the election will be won by a large margin, with the Democratic candidate John Crawley garnering 72% of the vote, while the losing Republican candidate Susan James will receive 28% of the vote.



**Treatment Group 2: Tight**

Reputable polls report Democratic and Republican candidates are neck-in-neck, with the election likely being won by a small margin by either party.
